**Dr Nonie Brennan - Report Release**





We are excited to announce the release of Thinker in Residence, Dr Nonie Brennan's final report from her time in Adelaide. Dr Brennan has produced a series of recommendations that focus on housing, support and systems, after meeting with over 30 organisations and engaging with over 500 people during her visit in November.

*'It was clear that inner-city homelessness services, local and state government representatives and Adelaide Zero Project stakeholders have a shared appetite for change. There are respected voices from all parties that continue to discuss the need for service and sector integration, and it is vital that they embrace opportunities to co-design solutions together. The vibrancy of the data that is now available from the By-Name List begins to tell the story of the real people behind the numbers and their experiences which form the statistics.... Adelaide has already shown it possesses the qualities required to make a lasting change and create a community where no one is homeless. Together you can end homelessness in 2020.'* said Dr Brennan.

We would like to thank Dr Brennan for her time, expertise and knowledge shared with our state.
