BEQUESTS

What is a Bequest?

A bequest can be a way of saying thank you to our organisation but it can also be a way of extending support for issues you hold dear into the future. Leaving a bequest in your Will can provide you with confidence that there will be people in the world continuing to passionately fight for causes and achieve outcomes for our society that you believe are important. Your bequest to the Don Dunstan Foundation will provide an important and everlasting benefit to humanity; an investment in the future well-being of the community and the continuing of Don Dunstan's vision for a just society. You will be actively ensuring that the Foundation can achieve its aims and objectives.

Types of Bequests

There are two types of bequests; unrestricted or restricted: Unrestricted Bequests
These are bequests where the benefactor places no restrictions on the use of the
bequest by the Don Dunstan Foundation. Designated Bequests These are bequests
where the benefactor stipulates the purpose for which they would like the bequest to
be used, usually from the existing range of activities conducted by the Foundation but
on occasion specifying a specific initiative within the scope and objectives of the
Foundation, for example, an art award or project such as homelessness & housing.

It is recommended that you speak to a financial adviser and/or lawyer when making your Will.

If you are considering leaving your bequest to the Don Dunstan Foundation we would appreciate being informed of your thoughts and intentions.

BEQUESTS

Your Bequest will help make the vision a reality

Bequests are a vital source of funding allowing long-term planning and are encouraged as a way of helping to ensure successful outcomes in relation to the work undertaken by The Don Dunstan Foundation in the future. You can help this work by including The Don Dunstan Foundation in your Will.

Your bequest to The Don Dunstan Foundation will be an investment in the future well-being of the Australian community, by supporting much needed research and educational programs, by inspiring individuals to contribute to public debate and the production of ideas, in shaping public thinking and in continuing the work towards implementing Don Dunstan's vision of a just society.

Suggested forms of Bequest wording

The following examples of wording are meant only as a guide to help you in leaving a Bequest in your Will to The Don Dunstan Foundation.

ENTIRE ESTATE

I GIVE to The Don Dunstan Foundation, 230 North Terrace, Adelaide University, South Australia, 5005, the whole of my estate of whatsoever nature or kind and wheresoever situated to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine and I DECLARE that the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer for the time being of the said Foundation shall be a full and sufficient discharge of this bequest to my executor(s) and Trustee(s).

RESIDUE OF AN ESTATE

I GIVE the residue of my real and personal property whatsoever or wheresoever situated to The Don Dunstan Foundation, 230 North Terrace, Adelaide University, South Australia, 5005, to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine and I DECLARE that the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer for the time being of the said Foundation shall be a full and sufficient discharge of this bequest to my executor(s) and Trustee(s).

REAL ESTATE

SPECIFIC PERSONAL PROPERTY

I GIVE mydescription of property, shares, furniture, work of art, etc..... free from all debts (secured or unsecured) and all duties (whether Federal or State) payable in respect of my estate to The Don Dunstan Foundation, 230 North Terrace, Adelaide University, South Australia, 5005, to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine and I DECLARE that the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer for the time being of the said Foundation shall be a full and sufficient discharge of this bequest to my executor(s) and Trustee(s).

A SPECIFIC LEGACY

Specifying what you are giving

Example 1

I GIVE the sum of \$........... to The Don Dunstan Foundation, 115 Grenfell Street, Adelaide, South Australia, 5005, to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine.

Example 2

I GIVE% of my estate free from all debts (secured and unsecured) and all duties (whether Federal or State) payable in respect of my estate to The Don Dunstan Foundation, 115 Grenfell Street, Adelaide, South Australia, 5005, to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine.

Example 3

I GIVE my Life Insurance PolicyInsurance Policy Details......free from all debts (secured and unsecured) and all duties (whether Federal or State) payable in respect of my estate to The Don Dunstan Foundation, 115 Grenfell Street, Adelaide, South Australia, 5005, to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine.

If you wish to leave a Bequest for specific purposes

You may prefer that the bequest you leave is used in a specific way or for a particular purpose. If this is the case, instead of the phrase "to be applied for the general purposes of the said Foundation in such manner as the Trustees of the said Foundation may determine" insert in its place wording which describes your preference for the way in which you would wish your gift to be used by the Trustees.

To enable the Foundation to fulfil your wishes, clearly state your preferences so that your intentions are easily understood. You may like to discuss your intentions with the Foundation prior to making your Bequest, to ensure that your wishes will be able to be fulfilled.

The following examples of wording are meant only as a guide to help you in leaving a Bequest for specific purposes in your Will to The Don Dunstan Foundation.

Examples

- "... to be applied for the purpose of scholarships by the said Foundation ..."
- "... to be applied for educational purposes by the said Foundation ..."
- "... to be applied for the purpose of research related to by the said Foundation ..."
- "... to be applied for the purpose ofby the said Foundation ..."
